(HANSLOPE FOOTPATH 3) (PART) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023

This Order is made by Milton Keynes City Council under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert that part of the footpath to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission reference 22/03213/FUL granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, for the new car park for the provision of 216 additional parking spaces, including 166 new employee parking spaces of which 24 will be EV charging points covered by a solar canopy and 50 new visitor parking spaces, as well as the re-assignment of 40 existing visitor spaces for employee use, along with the associated infrastructure, landscaping for use in connection with Hanslope Park

BY THIS ORDER:

- The footpath over the land shown by a bold black continuous line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be diverted as provided below and the Definitive Map and Statement for Milton Keynes shall be modified.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of Milton Keynes City Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said section of footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the confirmation of this Order when Milton Keynes Council have certified that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with and upon the occurrence of that diversion the Definitive map for Milton Keynes shall be modified by deleting from it the path or way referred to in Article 1 of this Order and

the path or way referred to in Article 2 of this Order shall be added to it and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule.

4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing path or way

The existing route is currently A-B, as shown by a bold black continuous line on the enclosed map. The route travels from point A (OS Grid Reference SP81288 45758) in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 174 metres to point B (OS Grid Reference SP81359 45599).

PART 2

Description of site of alternative highway

DESCRIPTION OF NEW WAY

The proposed diversion shall be A-C-D-E-B, as shown by a bold black dashed line on the enclosed map. The proposed diversion will travel from point A (OS Grid Reference SP81288 45758) in a generally south south westerly direction for approximately 94 metres to point C (OS Grid Reference SP81272 45624), then in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 29 metres to point D (OS Grid Reference SP81234 45652), then in a generally south south westerly direction for approximately 59 metres to point E (OS Grid Reference SP81226 45594), then in a generally easterly direction for approximately 135 metres until point B (OS Grid Reference SP81359 45599).

The proposed diversion will have a length of 316 metres and a width of 2 metres throughout.

From junction with Park Road to the south west of Hanslope, generally south easterly with deviations for 870 metres to junction with Bullington End Road. Continuing in south easterly direction for 1400 metres to junction with Haversham & Little Linford Footpath 9.
