## What is the All in 1 MK card?

### The All in 1 MK card is:

- A form of identity (with national PASS accreditation)
- A travel concessionary card
- A discount card for participating local stores, restaurants and services

### ...all rolled into 1 card!



### Can I apply for an All in 1 MK card?

To qualify for the scheme, you must be:

- Aged between 5 and 18 years
- A permanent resident of Milton Keynes or attending school or college in Milton Keynes
- In full-time education (those on training schemes do not qualify)

If you are 18 years of age you qualify up to and including the day before you turn 19 years.

### How do I apply?

**Step 1** Complete the form on the first page of this leaflet

**Step 2** Take the form and a passport sized photo to your school/college

**Step 3** The school/college stamp the form as proof that you are in full-time education NB if you are attending a non-compulsory full time further education course, a letter of confirmation from the school/college is also required, stating the nature and duration of the course

**Step 4** The school/college return the form, with the photo, to the Bus Card Section at Milton Keynes Council and your card will arrive shortly after that.

### How much does it cost?

All in 1 MK cards are issued free of charge. However, if you wish to use it as a concessionary travel card, you will need to pay for the journeys you make by bus and train using the following options:

Either: Junior Tripper - £3.50 for 10 journeys, you will be provided with a receipt showing your ten rides. Each time you travel, you must show your All in 1 MK card and provide your receipt to the driver to be clipped.

Or: Junior Cityrider - £5 for a weekly pass with unlimited travel, £17.50 for a monthly pass with unlimited travel. You will be given a receipt showing the expiry date. Each time you travel you must show your All in 1 MK card and Junior Cityrider receipt to the driver.

Or: Show your All in 1 MK card to the bus driver and you'll be able to purchase a ticket for a single journey for 35p.

Junior Tripper and Cityrider permits can be bought on MK Metro buses, at the Bus Station and at Discover MK, 672 Silbury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes. A validation receipt is given at the time of purchase showing the date of expiry and must be kept as proof to be shown to the bus driver on each journey. Unfortunately if the receipt is lost a duplicate cannot be issued and you will need to purchase another ticket.

### Using the All in 1 MK card for travel:

The All in 1 MK card can be used on most local buses within the Milton Keynes Council Area. They cannot be used for cross-boundary travel. Money lost due to lost tickets is non-refundable.

Cityriders are also valid at all times on London Midland train services between the six rail stations of Wolverton, Milton Keynes Central, Bletchley, Fenny Stratford, Bow Brickhill and Woburn Sands. Junior Trippers are not valid for travel on trains.

### Using the All in 1 MK card for discounts:

The All in 1 MK card can be used in stores, restaurants and services across Milton Keynes area to gain discounts or special offers. Places that accept the All in 1 MK card will be marked by an All in 1 MK card sign. You will need to show your card before making your purchase.

### Using the All in 1 MK card as a form of identification:

The All in 1 MK card can be used as a form of identification in places where you need to prove your age such as when buying age restricted products i.e. DVDs or entering an age restricted location i.e. the cinema. Simply show your All in 1 MK card as proof of your age.
