Unemployment – January 2023

Unemployment Data:

- The Unemployment Rate in MK was 3.4% in January 2023
 - The number of Claimants in Milton Keynes increased by 50 to 6,245 individuals between January 2023 and December 2022.
- The Unemployment Rate in Milton Keynes is <u>lower</u> than the national (UK) rate of 3.6%, but <u>higher</u> than the South East Midlands (SEMLEP) rate of 3.3%
