Adoption Statement

Notice is hereby given that Milton Keynes Council adopted the Milton Keynes Core Strategy Local Plan on 10th July 2013.

Production of the Core Strategy began in 2006 and the document has undergone extensive public consultation since then. Following examination hearings in July 2012, an independent Planning Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State concluded that the Core Strategy is 'sound', subject to the incorporation of main modifications which she has recommended. The adopted Core Strategy incorporates modifications recommended by the Inspector.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
- (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made within six weeks from the date of adoption of this Core Strategy, i.e. by Wednesday 21 August 2013.
