

Consultation on Neighbourhood Area Applications

Milton Keynes Council has received applications for the designation of two neighbourhood areas and, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations, 2012, the Council is carrying out a 6 week consultation on the proposed Neighbourhood Area from **Wednesday 19 February 2014 to Wednesday 2 April 2014.**
