## Our school population is

- **Fast growing**
  - **Increasingly diverse**
  - **Less disadvantaged compared to national**
- 
- 45,453 children and young people recorded in 2015 January school census
  - On roll at 110 maintained schools (2 nursery, 88 primary, 12 secondary, 6 special, 2 short stay)
  - **11.7%** of children in **primary** schools entitled to free school meals (FSM) (England 16.5%)
  - **11.3%** of children in **secondary** schools entitled to free school meals (FSM) (England 14.9%)

# Priority groups

Performance data identifies the following groups of pupils as priority groups:

- Disadvantaged groups supported by the Pupil Premium:
  - Pupils eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years
  - Children who have been in care continuously for more than 6 months
- Black African and White British heritage pupils
- Pupils with special educational needs or a disability
- Pupils in Care



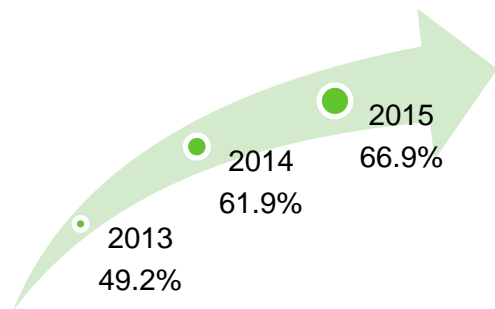

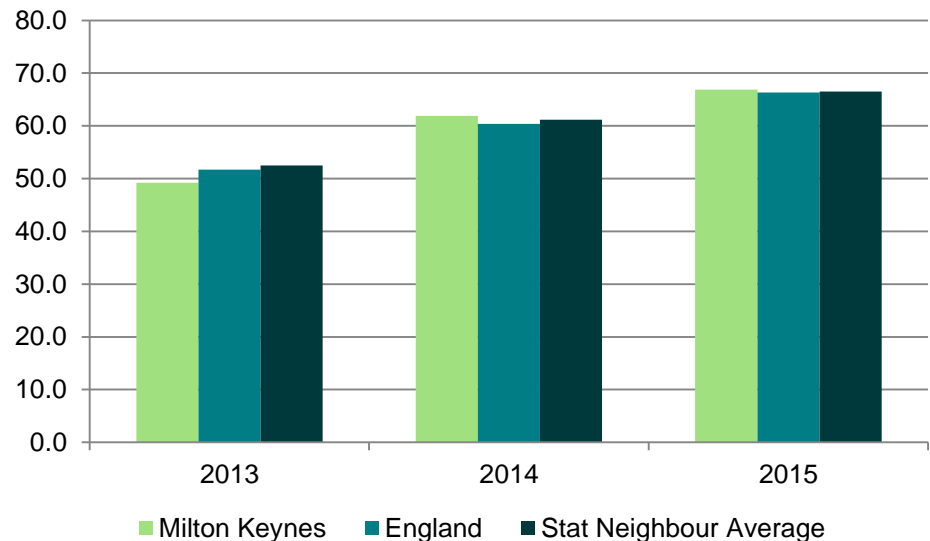

Milton Keynes growth in Percentage achieving a good level of development since 2013

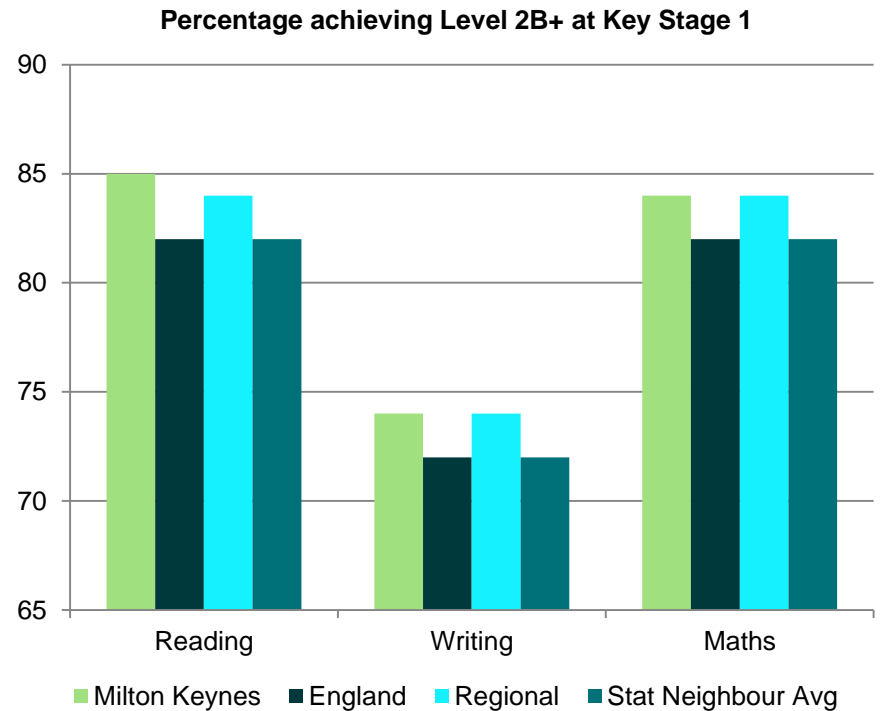
EYFSP 2015 – Percentage achieving a good level of development

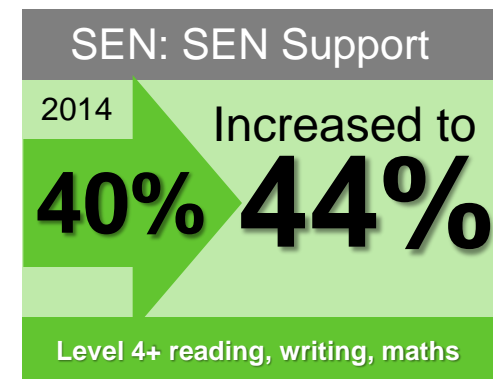

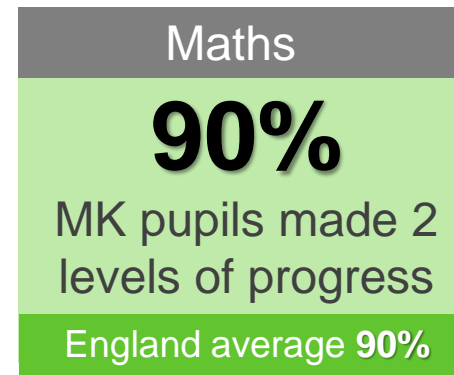
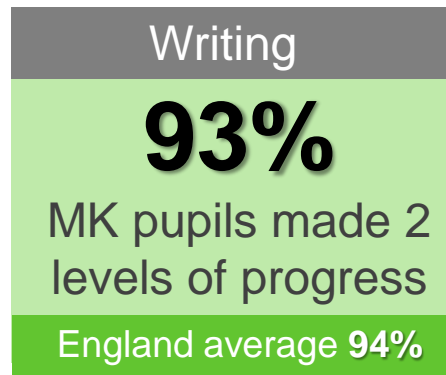
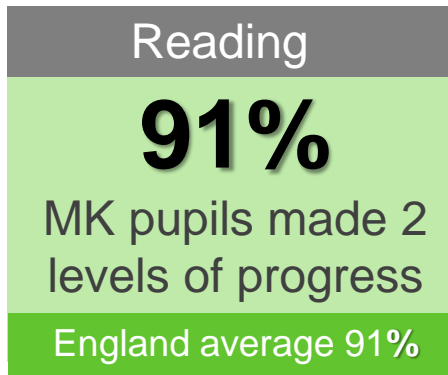
## Key Stage 2

## Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2

Pupils are expected to make 2 levels of progress (level 2 to level 4)



Progress by the end of Key Stage 4 was **lower** than the England levels

By the end of Key Stage 4

Pupils who reached level 4 at the end of Key Stage 2 should progress to achieve at least a Grade C at GCSE in English and maths

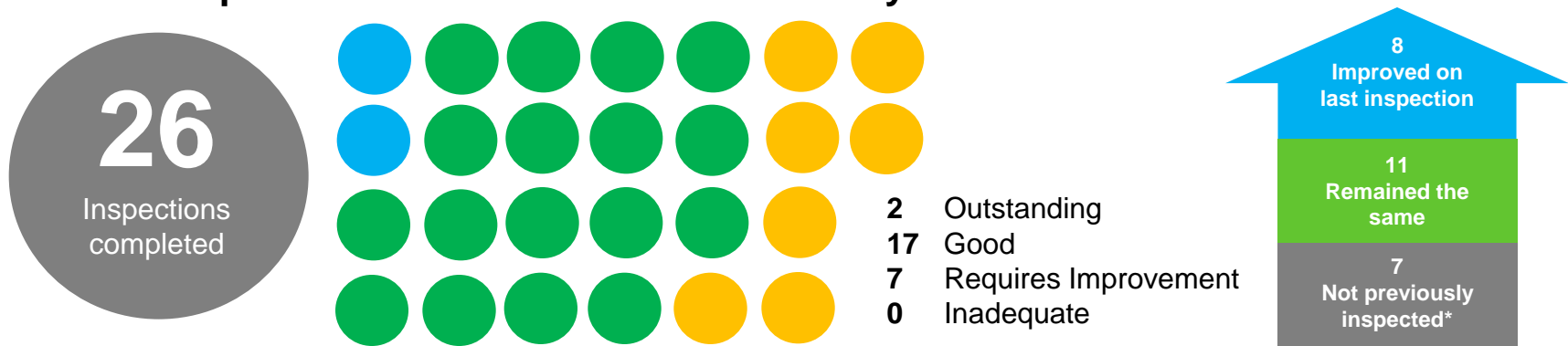
