

## Site Allocations Plan Statement of Matters

### Title Document

Milton Keynes Council Site Allocations Plan Proposed Submission Draft (2016).

### Subject Matter and Geographical Cover

The Proposed Submission Draft Site Allocations Plan has been prepared pursuant to the 2013 Core Strategy, which is the principal strategic spatial plan within the Development Plan for Milton Keynes. The Site Allocations Plan has been prepared to support the Development Strategy of the Borough and supplement housing land supply, which in the Core Strategy and Local Plan is reliant on large-scale expansion areas.

The draft Site Allocations Plan consists of 21 smaller allocations throughout the Milton Keynes urban area which have been selected on the basis of their suitability for residential development.

Once adopted, this document will form part of the Development Plan. The Site Allocations Plan is not part of the (longer term) Plan: MK process on which there will be separate proposals for consultation in due course. The Site Allocations Plan principally concerns the next five years, Plan: MK for the period until 2036.

### Period for Representations

The consultation runs for an eight week period, running from Wednesday 26 October 2016 to 5pm Wednesday 21 December 2016. Any person may make representations relating to the 'soundness' and legal compliance on the Council's proposals for the Plan within this consultation period.
