

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES) (VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN MILTON KEYNES) (DERESTRICTION) ORDER 2004) VARIATION ORDER 2018**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on 17<sup>th</sup> July 2018 made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 82 and 83 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The proposed Order will extend the 30mph speed restriction along A428, Lavendon.

The above changes come as a result of road safety to ensure vehicular speeds do not exceed 30mph at the new junction for the Old Stoneyard, Lavendon residential housing development. The reduction in vehicular speeds will enable a safer environment to be achieved throughout the above road and encourage and facilitate safer movements when vehicles are turning in and out of the new junction.

On 7<sup>th</sup> June 2018 Milton Keynes Council served the Notice of Proposal and carried out 21 days statutory consultation on the above proposal.


Milton Keynes Council received no objections to the proposals during the 21 statutory consultation periods.

The Traffic Regulation Order will come into effect on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2018.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any provision contained in the Orders on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under the Act has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
