

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (VARIOUS ROADS, CAMPBELL PARK) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on 5th June 2018 made the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the made Order will introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions along parts of Adelphi Street in Campbell Park (at its junction with Silbury Boulevard).

On 26th April 2018 Milton Keynes Council served the Notice of Proposal and began 21 days statutory consultation on the above proposed Traffic Regulation Order.

The Council received no objections to the proposed Traffic Regulation Order during the consultation period.

As a result the Council now intends on making the proposed Traffic Regulation Order which will come into effect on 11th June 2018.

A copy of the Order as made together with maps showing the areas referred to may be inspected during opening hours at **Milton Keynes Library**, 555 Silbury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes, and during normal office hours at Milton Keynes Council, Synergy Park, Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall, Milton Keynes, MK6 1LY.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any provision contained in the Orders on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under the Act has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.
