

World War II Gas Mask Craft



You will need:

Black A4 cardboard*
Brown card*
Clear plastic
Bubble wrap
Scissors
Stapler

1. Print off the template, and trace onto black card. Cut along all the solid lines and remove all sections with marked with an 'X'.
2. Fold the black card along the areas marked with a dotted line
3. Fold back the forehead section, overlap the sides and staple into place to start to create a 3D mask.
4. Cut out round circles of plastic slightly large than the eye holes and glue into place on the back of the mask.
5. Fold the lower section of the mouthpiece back onto itself, and then fold around to create a tube shape. Staple into place. Push bubble wrap along the tube to the end of the mouthpiece.
6. Create a head band. First staple a strip of brown card at ear level, then go around the head and staple in place on the other side at ear level. The add another strip of brown card at the top of the forehead, staple into place on the horizontal strap at the back of the head.
