The age range of the children will be from 4 to 11 years of age and will include children from the local schools. Hours will be arranged to suit the business need and the individual needs of staff and therefore we will consider full-time, part-time, permanent and temporary applications. Our Play Workers will work with our Play Leader to develop an engaging and entertaining programme including a wide range of activities which will be delivered on site at Bradwell Village School. The role will include:

- organising and directing the work of other play workers;
- planning and delivering a programme which includes a variety of play activities;
- overseeing play activities during the times of the wrap around care clubs;
- supervising play activities;
- liaising with parents and carers as appropriate;
- setting up and tidying away resources;
- organising, maintaining and cleaning play equipment, ensuring safe storage;
- implementing the school behaviour policy for the duration of the wrap around care sessions;
- developing and maintaining records, including undertaking the observation of children;
- handling cash in line with the school's finance policy;
- planning and preparing food and snacks;
- carrying out personal care and hygiene duties;
- carrying out first aid duties;
- supervising the transition of pupils to and from their educational setting.
