

WEPENER BRIDGE CONCRETE REPAIRS



As many of you will be aware from the advanced warning signs works are scheduled at Wepener Bridge to the West of the Tickford roundabout on the A422. Concrete repairs are required to the underside of the bridge. To facilitate this process off-peak traffic management will be required for the first and last two weeks of the works. We appreciate this is a very sensitive route and traffic flows will be monitored in the mornings before installing traffic management. No restriction of traffic flows should be seen before 9.30am.

A scheme has been produced and contractor appointed for these essential works. They are scheduled to commence on **Tuesday 12th February 2019** with a completion date by 3rd May 2019.

The works are to be undertaken by the Highway's Term Service Contractor Ringway in conjunction with sub-contractor's Freyssinet and F.j.Morris.
