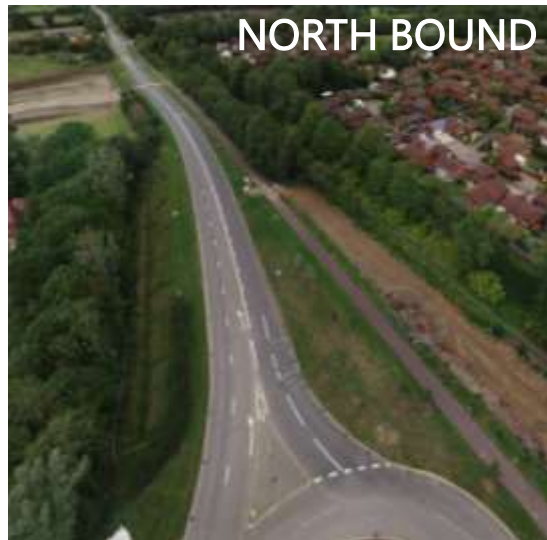

WHITEHOUSE UNDERPASS UPDATE

WEEK COMMENCING JUNE 17TH 2019

Introduction

As part of the Western expansion safe crossing points, an underpass is being constructed to the south of Whitehouse Roundabout (*see map*). This new underpass will provide a safe crossing point under the V4 and will join into the new Redway in Whitehouse and existing Redway on the V4.

Construction works began with the closure of the V4 on 10th June 2019. A road and Redway signed diversion is in place.

Photos left show the site during the mobilisation period and show what the road looked like prior to works commencing. We need to provide welfare for the operatives, storage and site security throughout the whole of the works.

Programme

We have a 10-month programme. With the current completion date of end April 2020. Like any major project, the programme can vary due to utility works, weather but any changes to these dates will be communicated out to stakeholders via signage near the site and on the website.

Works happening over the next couple of weeks

There are 6 utility supplies which require a diversion prior to the excavation and installation of the underpass. These are; Gas, Electric, Western Power Distribution, Virgin Media, City Fibre, Street Lighting. We will be excavating to allow them access to complete their works. The diversion of these utilities will not affect the supply to any properties in Milton Keynes.
