

STATEMENT OF REASONS

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES

RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2015) VARIATION ORDER 2019**

The effect of the above Order will be to introduce 'no waiting at any time' restrictions at the junction of Dunthorne Way and Nicholson Grove in Grange Farm.

The effect of the above Order will be to extend the existing 'no waiting at any time' restriction along the southern kerblines of Dunthorne Way in Grange Farm by 24 metres.

The proposed waiting restrictions come as a result of obstruction caused by parked vehicles near to the bus stop on Dunthorne Way.

The proposed waiting restrictions will help to prevent vehicles from parking and causing obstruction to the bus stop.

The Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes as Highway Authority for Dunthorne Way in Grange Farm is satisfied that it is expedient to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 pursuant to sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) for the following reasons:-

- 1) To maintain a safe environment throughout the road, particularly to encourage and facilitate pedestrian and cyclist movements on this road;
- 2) For avoiding danger to people or other traffic using the above roads, or any other road, or to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising.
