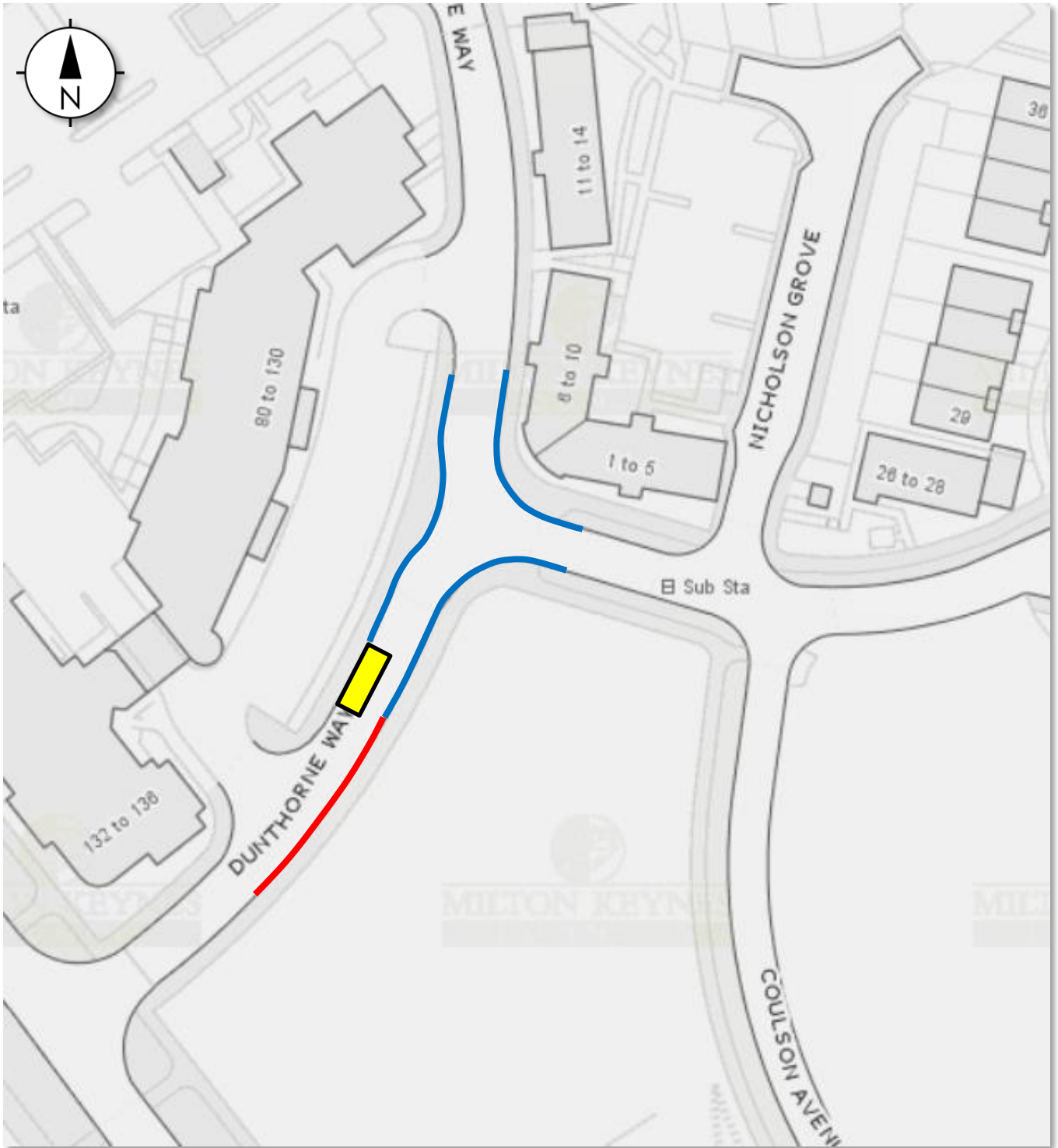

Guidance on 'no waiting at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines)

The no waiting restriction prevents motorists from stopping at the side of the road for safety reasons and/or to aid in preventing traffic congestion.

The restriction applies from the centre of the carriageway to the highway boundary including any footway or grass verge that forms part of the highway.

The extent of the restriction is identified through the painting of double yellow lines in front of the kerb line.

Any vehicle parked on or adjacent to the double yellow lines, which are not exempt from the restriction, will be in contravention of the 'no waiting' restriction and may be issued with a penalty charge notice.

The following exemptions apply to double yellow lines:-

- Vehicles are permitted to park when loading or unloading for commercial purposes. However, this must be obvious to the Civil Enforcement Officer (parking attendant).
- Vehicles are permitted to briefly stop on double yellow lines in order to pick up or drop off passengers.
- Vehicles which display a valid blue badge are permitted to park on double yellow lines for up to a maximum of 3 hours and must display the blue badge at all times as well as the accompanying time clock.
- Emergency service vehicles are permitted to park on double yellow lines only when on operational duties.
