RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2015) VARIATION ORDER 2019**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Orders under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the above Order will be to extend the existing 'no waiting at any time' restriction along the southern kerbline of Dunthorne Way in Grange Farm by 24 metres.

The proposed waiting restrictions come as a result of obstruction caused by parked vehicles near to the bus stop on Dunthorne Way.

The proposed waiting restrictions will help to prevent vehicles from parking and causing obstruction to the bus stop.

Milton Keynes Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the areas referred to along with a statement of reason for proposing the Order, may be inspected during opening hours at Milton Keynes Library, 555 Silbury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes, and during normal office hours at Milton Keynes Council, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Milton Keynes.

Any objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be **made in writing** and sent to the Network TRO Manager, Highways Department, Public Realm Services Group, Synergy Park, Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall, Milton Keynes, MK6 1LY **to be received** no later than **22nd August 2019** quoting reference **TRO-264**.
