

PRODUCTION OF MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

Section 57(2) - Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976

Milton Keynes Council (“the Council”) requires all new applicants to have been assessed as meeting the requirements of the DVLA Vocational Group 2 standard in order to be satisfied that they are fit and proper to be licensed. Applicants are therefore required to be assessed to meet this standard by a medical practitioner completing the DVLA’s D4 Medical Examination Report form. Following examination the medical practitioner must give the completed forms back to the applicant who is then responsible for providing them to the Council as part of his/her application/renewal. Enclosed is the DVLA’s D4 Medical Examination Report form.

A medical examination must be undertaken when an applicant first applies for a licence and then again at the ages of 45, 50, 55, 60, 65 and thereafter annually. The Council may also request further medicals to be undertaken at any time as set out in the Council’s Policy.

The Council is aware of four local medical centres that provide D4 medical assessments (listed below). An applicant can contract any of these providers or choose to undertake a D4 medical assessment with a medical practitioner of their choice (such as your own GP). The cost of this and any other subsequent medicals requested by the Council must be met by the applicant.
