THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (GOLDEN DRIVE (PART), EAGLESTONE (RESIDENTS PERMIT PARKING AREA) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1) and 35, 35A and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be as follows:-

- To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions along parts of Golden Drive in Eaglestone and at its junctions with Saxon Street (V7), Marlborough Street (V8), Griffon Drive, Osprey Drive, Peregrine Close, Harlans Close, Hawkmoor Close and Montagu Drive;
- To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions along parts of Harrier Drive in Eaglestone and at its junctions with Saxon Street (V7), Marlborough Street (V8), Harrier Court, High Trees, Condor Close, Great Denson, Broad Dean, North Ridge, Ferndale, Buckingham Gate, Abbotsfield and Forest Rise;
- To introduce a residents permit parking area for the cul-de-sac on Golden Drive in Eaglestone for even numbers 144 and 158 Golden Drive.

The proposed no waiting restrictions come as a result of the inconsiderate and obstructive parking on Harrier Drive and Golden Drive at junctions and pedestrian crossing points which is causing road safety concerns for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

The proposed residents permit parking area comes as a result of long term parking from staff and visitors of the Hospital which is causing a nuisance to local residents.

The above proposed restrictions will alleviate obstruction and nuisance parking and help to create a safer environment for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists throughout.


