

Plastic Bottle Top Card Craft

Beautiful homemade cards just using things from home



Also suitable for Mother's Day, Father's Day and birthday cards

You will need:

Colourful A4 card or paper
Cereal boxes
Pencil
Googly eyes

Plastic bottle lids
Scissors
Felt tip pens

1. Fold the colourful A4 card or paper in half.
2. Then, cut open an old cereal box.
3. On the brown inside of the cereal box, use a pencil to draw around the plastic bottle lid.
4. Take off the plastic lid and draw petals around the circle you have just drawn. Using scissors cut out the flower head shape.
5. Put glue on the brown side of the flower head shape and stick onto the folded card or paper, towards the top edge.
6. Glue the top of the plastic bottle lid and place in the centre of the flower head.
7. Cut out and add more flowers if desired.
8. Using the leftover cardboard colour cut out a stalk and leaves and colour in using a green felt tip pen. Glue onto the card underneath the flower head.
9. Add your message to the front and inside.

Optional ladybird:

On a red plastic bottle lid use a black felt tip pen to draw on spots and add googly eyes.
