

Newport Road -Traffic Calming Works

The installation of Traffic Calming measures along Newport Road was suspended in March along with other works due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

Since then MK Council has been working closely with their highways service provider, Ringway to put plans in place to reschedule the works whilst meeting the UK Government's guidance for social distancing on site.

Therefore, the work will start on **Monday 11 May 2020** and will take around 5-6 weeks to complete (weather permitting).

How this may affect you:

- To ensure that the works can be carried out safely it will be necessary to close some sections of Newport Road to through traffic as each work phase takes place. A diversion route will be clearly signed for any closures.
- The work will take place between 8am to 5pm Monday to Friday.
- Limited access for local vehicles will be maintained e.g. for driveways, except on the sections of road being worked on. Please ensure you park your vehicle in a suitable location out of the area of if you require continuous access throughout the day.
- Footpaths and the redway will remain fully open with some minor restrictions.
- Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained at all times.

The attached drawing shows the scope of the works.

Important Notice:

All MK Council highways and Ringway employees are classed as 'key workers' under current UK Government legislation and as such are permitted to work on the highway in MK.

Each worker carries a letter as proof of their individual key worker status.
