NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2), 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to alter the existing 'no waiting at any time' restrictions on Countess Way at its junction with Warwick Avenue in Broughton to accommodate the new proposed zebra crossing "**The Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes (Zebra Pedestrian Crossing on Countess Way, Boughton) 2020**".

The Council is now formally consulting on the zebra crossing and the proposed alterations to the 'no waiting at any time' restrictions.
