NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (ZEBRA PEDESTRIAN CROSSING ON COUNTESS WAY, BROUGHTON) 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to establish a pedestrian crossing under section 23(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act).

The type of crossing will be a '**Zebra pedestrian crossing**', the construction of which will be carried out in accordance with the manner prescribed by regulations under section 25 of the Act.

The Zebra crossing will be located on Countess Way in Broughton.

The crossing on the eastbound carriageway (including the white zig zags) will commence from a point 7.25 metres west of a point in line with the centre line of Warwick Avenue and will continue for 32 metres in a westerly direction. The centre point of the crossing will be at a point approximately 23 metres west of a point in line with the centre line of Warwick Avenue.

The width of the crossing will be 5.2 metres.

The crossing on the westbound carriageway (including the white zig zags) will commence from a point 3 metres west of a point in line with the centre line of Warwick Avenue and will continue for 32 metres in a westerly direction. The centre point of the crossing will be at a point approximately 23 metres west of a point in line with the centre line of Warwick Avenue.

The width of the crossing will be 5.2 metres.

The Council is now formally consulting on the proposed zebra crossing and copies of the statement of reason and a plan showing the location of the crossing may be inspected on the Council's website at: www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations.
