

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (A421, MILTON KEYNES) (24 HOUR CLEARWAY AND PROHIBITION OF RIGHT TURN) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be as follows:

- 1) To introduce a 24-hour clearway restriction on both sides of the A421 from its junction with Kingston Roundabout to the Milton Keynes and Bedfordshire borough boundary.
- 2) To prohibit right turn manoeuvres from the unnamed access leading to Pond 3A onto A421. All vehicles entering onto the A421 from the unnamed access road shall turn left only.

The proposals form part of the A421 dual carriageway scheme and will tie-in with Central Bedfordshire Councils 24-hour clearway and no left turns on the A421.

The Council is now formally consulting on the proposed restrictions.
