PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14 AND WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53A(2)

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (FOOTPATH 25 NEWPORT PAGNELL (PART)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021

The above Order was made on 9 March 2021. The effect of the Order will be to divert part of Public Footpath 25 Newport Pagnell from point A at OS Grid Reference SP 87690 43866 at an alleyway between 20-22 St John Street, Newport Pagnell, travelling in a general south-south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres to point B at OS Grid Reference SP 87686 43857, then continuing in a general south-south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 32 metres to terminate at point C at OS Grid Reference SP 87671 43827 at the Silver Street public car park. This part of Footpath 25 Newport Pagnell has a length of approximately 42 metres and a width that varies between 0.8–1.2 metres from points A-B and a width that varies between 1.2–1.5 metres from points B-C, and is indicated on the Order map by a bold black continuous line.

The Order will then create an alternative footpath running from point D at OS Grid Reference SP 87679 43871 travelling in a general south-south westerly direction for approximately 6 metres to point E at OS Grid Reference SP 87676 43865, then in a general south easterly direction for approximately 6 metres to point F at OS Grid Reference SP 87678 43859, then continuing in a general south-south westerly direction for approximately 26 metres to point G at OS Grid Reference SP 87666 43836, then in a general west-north westerly direction for approximately 5 metres to point H at OS Grid Reference SP 87662 43837, then travelling in a general south-south westerly direction for approximately 1.8 metres to point I at OS Grid Reference SP 87661 43835, continuing in a general east-south easterly direction for approximately 9 metres to point J at OS Grid Reference SP 87670 43832, then in a general south-south westerly direction for approximately 1.8 metres to point K at OS Grid Reference SP 87669 43831, then travelling in a general west-north westerly direction for approximately 9 metres to point L at OS Grid Reference SP 87660 43834, then in a general south-south westerly direction for approximately 1.8 metres to point M at OS Grid Reference SP 87660 43832, continuing in a general east-south easterly direction for approximately 13 metres to point C at OS Grid Reference SP 87686 43857, as indicated on the Order map by bold black dashed lines.

The alternative footpath will have a length of approximately 79 metres and a width of 1.8 metres throughout. A ramp with landing places will be present at points I-J-K-L-M-C at a gradient not exceeding 1:12.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
