

Bow Brickhill Parish Council Budget 2021/22

Bow Brickhill Parish Council faced a difficult decision in terms of setting its budget and precept for 2021/22.

For a good while now the council has been setting a deficit budget (where income is significantly less than expenditure). To make up the difference, the council has been using its reserves or savings. This is obviously a position which can't be sustained in the long term.

So the difficult decision was made to increase the precept to £27,000. This still results in a use of reserves (£6,938) for 2021/22. It does however ensure that the council is able to meet its financial obligations notably in terms of running the pavilion, looking after the sports pitches, the play area, cutting the grass, emptying the dog bins and maintaining the defibrillators and noticeboard.

This increase equates to a Band D charge of £101.29 per annum, which is an annual increase per Band D household of £38.56 or 74p per week.
