Crane Licence

1. I/We undertake and agree to set up and maintain the crane, and continue the licence in all respects to the satisfaction of the council and in accordance with the statutory provisions attached, which I/We acknowledge to have carefully read, and in conformity with the conditions and regulations therewith.
2. The licensee should ensure that they are in possession of a valid insurance policy for Public Liability to the value of £5,000,000.
3. The licensee shall indemnify and hold harmless the council against all liability, claims and demands whatsoever in connection with or arising out of the erection, maintenance, existence and/or removal of the hoarding, scaffolding, platform, handrail, etc, referred to.
4. Before or immediately following the removal of any hoarding, scaffolding, fencing, platforms, handrail, etc, the licensee shall level and make safe the surface of the public highway, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the council against all liability, claims and demands whatsoever in the event of any accident, occurrence, subsidence or sinking of the surface of the public way, or the execution or non-execution of any work, or anything whatsoever arising thereat. All hoards, scaffolds, fencing, platforms, handrails, etc, be erected and maintained to the satisfaction of the engineer and their approval endorsed upon the licence
5. The licensee should ensure that they are in possession of a valid insurance policy for Public Liability to the value of £5,000,000. The licensee shall indemnify and hold harmless the council against all liability, claims and demands whatsoever in connection with or arising out of the erection, maintenance, existence and/or removal of the hoarding, scaffolding, platform, handrail, etc, referred to. Before or immediately following the removal of any hoarding, scaffolding, fencing, platforms, handrail, etc, the licensee shall level and make safe the surface of the public highway, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the council against all liability, claims and demands whatsoever in the event of any accident, occurrence, subsidence or sinking of the public way, or the execution or non-execution of any work, or anything whatsoever arising thereat. All hoards, scaffolds, fencing, platforms, handrails, etc, be erected and maintained to the satisfaction of the engineer and their approval endorsed upon the licence.
