

Weddings and Civil Partnerships (CP) from the 19 July 2021

Weddings and civil partnerships may take place for unlimited numbers and are permitted in specified locations with appropriate measures in place.

Unlimited numbers must still be within the permitted numbers for the space for health and safety and fire regulations.

In Milton Keynes this means:

- weddings and civil partnerships may take place for the number of people shown on a building's licence and risk assessment with appropriate measures in place.
- the "no legal limit" on attendees is subject to the numbers shown in the risk assessment and license above.
- for a statutory wedding / CP this is the couple and two witnesses only;
- for Flowers Suite in Civic, the couple and a maximum of 48 guests (this includes children), two of these guests will be your witnesses.
- for licensed venues, up to a maximum number of people, or fewer, shown in their risk assessment and license.
- content is no longer restricted to statutory elements only; face masks are recommended and should be worn if possible and people should remain cautious when mixing with others.

Confirmation of the above was received from government on 12 July.

Please note: Milton Keynes Council will keep some social distancing measures in place at its sites even when government guidelines change. This includes all staff wearing face masks / face shields and maintaining a distance from others.
