

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (HIGH STREET, NEW BRADWELL) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2021**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2021 made an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along the following length of road High Street, New Bradwell from its junction with Church Street to its junction with St James Street in order to reconstruct footway, to install a new access to development, install new speed ramps and resurface road. Utility connection works will be undertaken at the same time. the temporary closure will be in effect on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and will remain in effect until 6<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

Whilst the above length of road is closed, the alternative route will be via Newport Road, Church Street, St Giles Street, St James Street, St Mary Street, St James Street, St Giles Street, St James Street, King Edward Street, St James Street (And Vice Versa).

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency services vehicles on operational duties and Residents.

The closure will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual.

The temporary closure will be in force on the date shown when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs displayed in the affected part of road.

All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closure at least one week prior to works taking place.

The proposed Order will come into operation on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021 and will continue in force for a maximum period of 3 month or until the said works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. If the works are not completed within the maximum period stated, a further order may be made.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
