## NOTICE OF MAKING

### PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF  
SCHEDULE 14 AND WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53A(2)**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (HANSLOPE FOOTPATH 53  
(PART)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021**

The above Order was made on 17 August 2021. The effect of the Order will be to divert part of Hanslope Footpath 53 which runs from point A (OS Grid Reference SP 79867 46261) in a generally west north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 129 metres to point B (OS Grid Reference SP 79744 46298), then in generally west north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 37 metres to point C (OS Grid Reference SP 79707 46303), then in generally south westerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres to point D (OS Grid Reference SP 79702 46295), this footpath has a length of approximately 176 metres and a width throughout of 1 metre and is indicated on the Order map by a bold black continuous line.

The Order will then create an alternative footpath running from point E (OS Grid Reference SP 79862 46250) in a generally north westerly direction for approximately 16 metres to point F (OS Grid Reference 79851 46262), then in a generally west north westerly direction for approximately 117 metres to point G (OS Grid Reference 79738 46295), then in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 35 metres to point D (OS Grid Reference SP 79702 46295) as indicated on the Order map by bold black dashed lines.

The alternative footpath will have a length of approximately 168m and a width of 1.8 metres throughout.

Anonymous objections cannot be accepted.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
