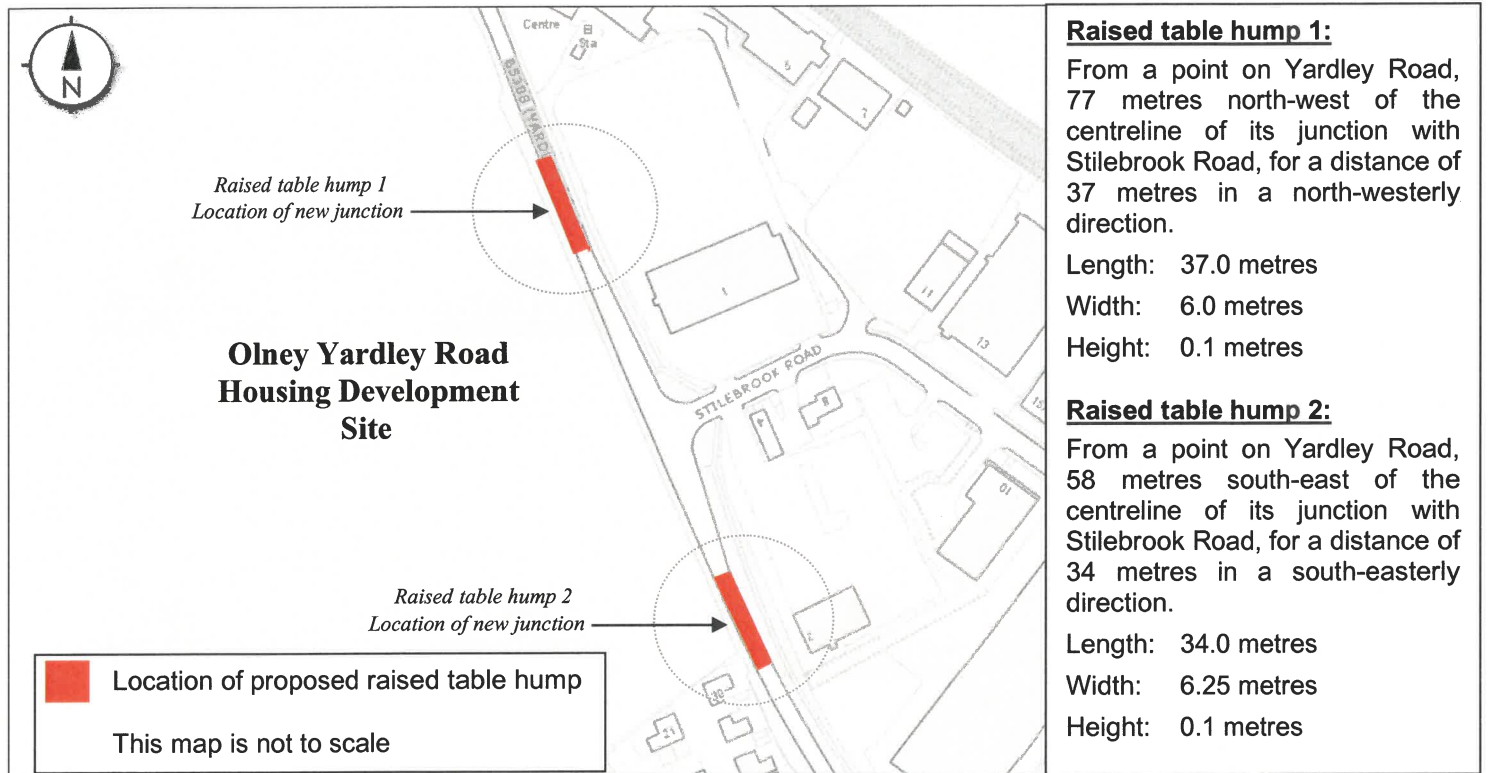


PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME ON YARDLEY ROAD, OLNEY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 to construct traffic calming measures consisting of two raised table humps to be placed along parts of Yardley Road, Olney.

The proposed raised table humps will support the new junctions for the Olney Yardley Road housing development.



The raised table hump will be constructed of “bituminous material or similar and will have a central lift of 100 millimetre”.

The Council is now serving formal notification on the proposed raised table hump and copies of the statement of reason and a plan showing the location of the crossing may be inspected on the Council’s website at: www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/consultations. Any representations about or objections to the proposed raised table hump, together with the grounds upon which they are made, must be made in writing and sent to the Council’s Traffic Regulation Order Team at Milton Keynes Council, Synergy Park, Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall, Milton Keynes, MK6 1LY, or by email to TROteam@milton-keynes.gov.uk quoting reference **NOT-038b** and to be received no later than **7th October 2021**.

Any representations received will be taken into consideration before the implementation of the scheme.
