TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Central Bedfordshire Council has made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle, except a vehicle being used for fire, police or ambulance purposes in an emergency, from proceeding along the length of C83, Woburn From Leighton St Pinfold Pond to Little Brickhill (near the CBC border).

This temporary closure is required to enable carriageway patching work to take place and shall apply to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by the appropriate traffic signs. Where possible access will be maintained to property and premises but may be restricted from time to time according to local signing.

It is expected that the works will take place over FIVE DAYS from 21st to 23rd September 2021 between the hours of 8:00 and 18:00. The road will be closed at all times during this period.

The alternative route for this closure is via Leighton Street, Sheep Lane, A5
The Order will come into operation on 21 September 2021 for a period of twelve months or until the proposed works have been completed, as detailed above, whichever is the earlier.
