# **Unemployment – May 2023**

#### **Unemployment Data:**

- The Unemployment Rate in Milton Keynes was 3.6% in May 2023
  - The number of Claimants in Milton Keynes decreased by 150 to 6,650 individuals between April 2023 and May 2023.
- The Unemployment Rate in Milton Keynes is <u>lower</u> than the national (UK) rate of 3.7%, but **higher** than the South East Midlands (SEMLEP) rate of 3.5%
