Unemployment – June 2023

Unemployment Data:

- The Unemployment Rate in Milton Keynes was 3.6% in June 2023
 - The number of Claimants in Milton Keynes increased by 135 to 6,690 individuals between May 2023 and June 2023.
- The Unemployment Rate in Milton Keynes is <u>lower</u> than the national (UK) rate of 3.7%, but **higher** than the South East Midlands (SEMLEP) rate of 3.5%

• Levels of unemployment were highest in the wards of Woughton and Fishermead (7.3%), Bletchley East (6.3%) and Central Milton Keynes (6.2%).
