Unemployment Data:

- The Unemployment Rate in MK was 3.8% in October 2022
 - The number of Claimants in Milton Keynes increased by 130 to 6,410 individuals between September 2022 and October 2022.
- The Unemployment Rate in Milton Keynes is <u>higher</u> than the national (UK) rate of 3.6% and the South East Midlands (SEMLEP) rate of 3.5%
