Unemployment Data:

- The Unemployment Rate in MK was 4.3% in **February 2022**
 - The number of Claimants in Milton Keynes increased by 165 to 7,315 individuals between February 2022 and January 2022.
- The Unemployment Rate in Milton Keynes is <u>equal to</u> the national (UK) rate of 4.3% but <u>higher</u> than the South East Midlands (SEMLEP) rate of 4.2%


In February 2022, there were **eight** wards within Milton Keynes with unemployment rates above the borough average of 4.3%.
