
SUMMARY OF DOMESTIC EXEMPT BUILDINGS



In addition to those examples given above a householder may construct a detached building designed to shelter people from the effects of nuclear, chemical or conventional weapons where its floor area does not exceed 30m² and the excavation for the building is no closer to any exposed part of another building or structure than a distance equal to the depth of the excavation plus one metre without submitting a Building Regulations Application.

Non Domestic Exemptions

Detached buildings into which people cannot or do not normally go and detached buildings housing fixed plant and machinery which are only visited intermittently to inspect or maintain the plant or machinery are also exempt from the provisions of the regulations.
