A strong start to early education for 2, 3 and 4 year olds

Moorlands Centre Nursery School is a 72 place, Local Authority Nursery School which forms part of Moorlands Family Centre, situated on Beanhill. It was described by Ofsted (July 2018) in the following terms:

‘Both the 2Nursery and the 3Nursery are vibrant and caring environments in which children can investigate and discover new things. Children arrive for their session excited to see what the day holds for them. Children make good progress in all areas of learning.’

We offer universally funded places in the morning or afternoon sessions for 3 and 4 year olds and some ‘30 hour provision’ places for parents who are eligible for this funding. 2 year old places for children who are eligible for the ‘Time for Twos’ funding are also on offer.

You are welcome to come into the Centre any time to have a look around the Nursery and discuss your requirements with the Headteacher or any member of the Nursery staff.
