Mini Eco Warrior Challenge Sheet

Autumn Term – Harry the hedgehog





Harry is a cheeky hedgehog who loves to snuffle around in the autumn leaves to find bugs, slugs and berries. But sometimes in amongst the leaves Harry finds rubbish which can hurt him.

Visit www.milton-keynes.gov.uk/kidsrecycle and using the EYFS/KS1 worksheets pick 3 of the following challenges to help Harry:

- Craft. Colour in and then glue on newspaper prickles to make your own Harry the Hedgehog collage
- **Eye spy.** Pick an adult and chat to them about the rubbish you see when you are out walking. Print off one of the Eye Spy sheets and see if you can spot the street bins near where you live.
- Collect leaves, pine cones and conkers to make a nice autumn display. Afterwards put them in the green wheeled bin or compost bin so they can be turned into soil.
- **Recycle Wall Chart**. Colour in the chart every time you help to put the rubbish and recycling in the correct bins at home.
- **Promise.** Sign the Litter Pledge to promise to always put your rubbish in the bin so it doesn't hurt Harry and other animals.
