Recycled bird feeder

Help feed the birds in winter



You will need:

Empty juice carton	Scissors
2 green plastic lids	2 small white plastic lids
Glue	Googly eyes
Old pencil / small stick	String//ribbon

- 1. Rinse out an empty juice carton. Use scissors to cut a U shape to create long wings on each side and fold so stick out slightly.
- Cut out an arched hole in the front of the carton so the bird food can go inside. Remember to leave a small section at the bottom so that the food doesn't fall out.
- 3. Glue plastic bottle lids on the front and add googly eyes.
- 4. Add a small triangle of cardboard/paper under the eyes for a beak.
- 5. Make a small hole in the front and poke through an old pencil or small stick to make a perch of the birds to sit on.
- 6. Add a string or ribbon to the top of the carton.
- 7. Fill the feeder with bird seed or chopped up, leftover fruit, such as apples, grapes and oranges.
- 8. Hang up your bird feeder in the garden and watch for birds coming to enjoy it.
