

A medium-term primary RE scheme of work is available from the Diocese of Oxford RE Team

If you want to be able to offer challenging and effective RE to your pupils, encouraging them to use higher order thinking skills that will impact on all their learning, you will be interested to learn that the Diocese of Oxford RE Team has produced a scheme of work. This will deliver the Milton Keynes syllabus, whilst reflecting the latest in enquiry-based RE.

The scheme contains 36 units for Y1 through to Y6, covering a range of topics. Each unit is question based and has a class record assessment sheet, with appropriately levelled statements of attainment. Currently the faiths covered are Christianity, Judaism, Hinduism & Sikhism; units on Islam will follow in the new academic year, but the question-based approach can be adapted to other faiths as required.

The working document is on offer for the price of £200 and a twilight staff training session can be provided as part of the package. It is hoped that purchasing schools will offer feedback to the RE team to ensure that the material remains up-to-date and relevant.
