

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (VARIOUS ROADS, MILTON KEYNES) (PEDESTRIAN ZONES) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes has on **18<sup>th</sup> January 2022** made the above Experimental Traffic Order under Sections 9 and 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purposes of carrying out an experimental scheme of parking control for a period of **18 months**.

The general effect of the experimental Order will be to introduce two prohibition of motor vehicle restrictions along the following lengths of road: -

<b>Length of road to be prohibited:</b>	<b>Prescribed Times:</b>
St Georges Road, Bletchley Between its junction with St Clements Drive and its junction with St Patricks Way	Monday to Friday, Between 8:15am and 8:55am Between 2:45pm and 3:30pm
Highland Close, Bletchley Its entire length from its junction with Kincardine Close	Monday to Friday, Between 8:20am and 8:55am Between 2:45pm and 3:30pm

The Council is satisfied that the experimental restrictions are necessary to trial Pedestrian Zones (School Streets) outside two schools during drop off and pick up times.

The Experimental Order will come into effect on **31<sup>st</sup> January 2022** for a period of 18-months.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person wishing to object to the making of the Experimental Order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation should put their objection **in writing** stating the title of the relevant Order, and the grounds on which the objection is made, and send to the Council's Traffic Regulation Order Team at Milton Keynes Council, Synergy Park, Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall, Milton Keynes, MK6 1LY, or by email to [TROteam@milton-keynes.gov.uk](mailto:TROteam@milton-keynes.gov.uk) quoting reference **ETRO-021**, to be received within a period of 6 months beginning with the day on which the Experimental Order comes into operation, i.e. **to be received by the Council no later than 31<sup>st</sup> July 2022**.
