

Consultation on Neighbourhood Area Application

Milton Keynes Council has received an application for the designation of a neighbourhood area and, in accordance with Regulation 6 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations, 2012, the Council is carrying out a 6 week consultation on the proposed Neighbourhood Area from **Friday 21st February to Friday 3rd April 2020**.
