As you will be aware, the Fullers Slade community within the red line area will be voting on regeneration options on **Friday 29 November** (2pm to 9pm) and **Saturday 30 November** 2019 (10am to 4pm) at the Rowans Family Centre, Moorfoot.

If option 2 or 3 is chosen, MKC will continue to work with residents to develop the designs ahead of a planning application being submitted next year.
