

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER**

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257 AND
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53A(2)**

**THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES
(CALVERTON FOOTPATH 50) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
2022**

This Order is made by the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert those parts of the footpaths to which this Order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission reference 05/00291/MKPCO, granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely the development of Land Off Watling Street (V4) Western Expansion Area Milton Keynes Buckinghamshire

This Order is also made under Section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for Milton Keynes require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The Calverton Footpath 50 over the land shown by a bold black continuous line on the attached map and described in Part 1(1) of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be diverted as provided below and the Definitive Map and Statement for Milton Keynes shall be modified.
2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said section of footpath as provided in Part 2(1) of the Schedule and shown by bold black dashes on the attached map.

3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which Milton Keynes Council certifies that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with and upon the occurrence of that diversion the Definitive map for Milton Keynes shall be modified by deleting from it the path or way referred to in Article 1 of this Order and the path or way referred to in Article 2 of this Order shall be added to it and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule
4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpaths are diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing path or way

(1) Existing Calverton Footpath 50

From point A (OS Grid Reference SP80519 37510) in generally east south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 517 metres to point B (OS Grid Reference SP81021 37426).

The existing path has a length of approximately 517 metres and a width of 1 metre throughout and is indicated by the points stated above on the Order map by a bold black continuous line.

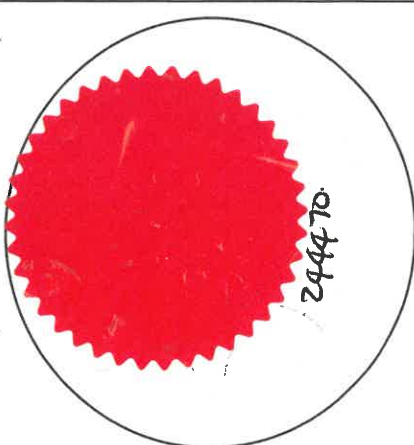
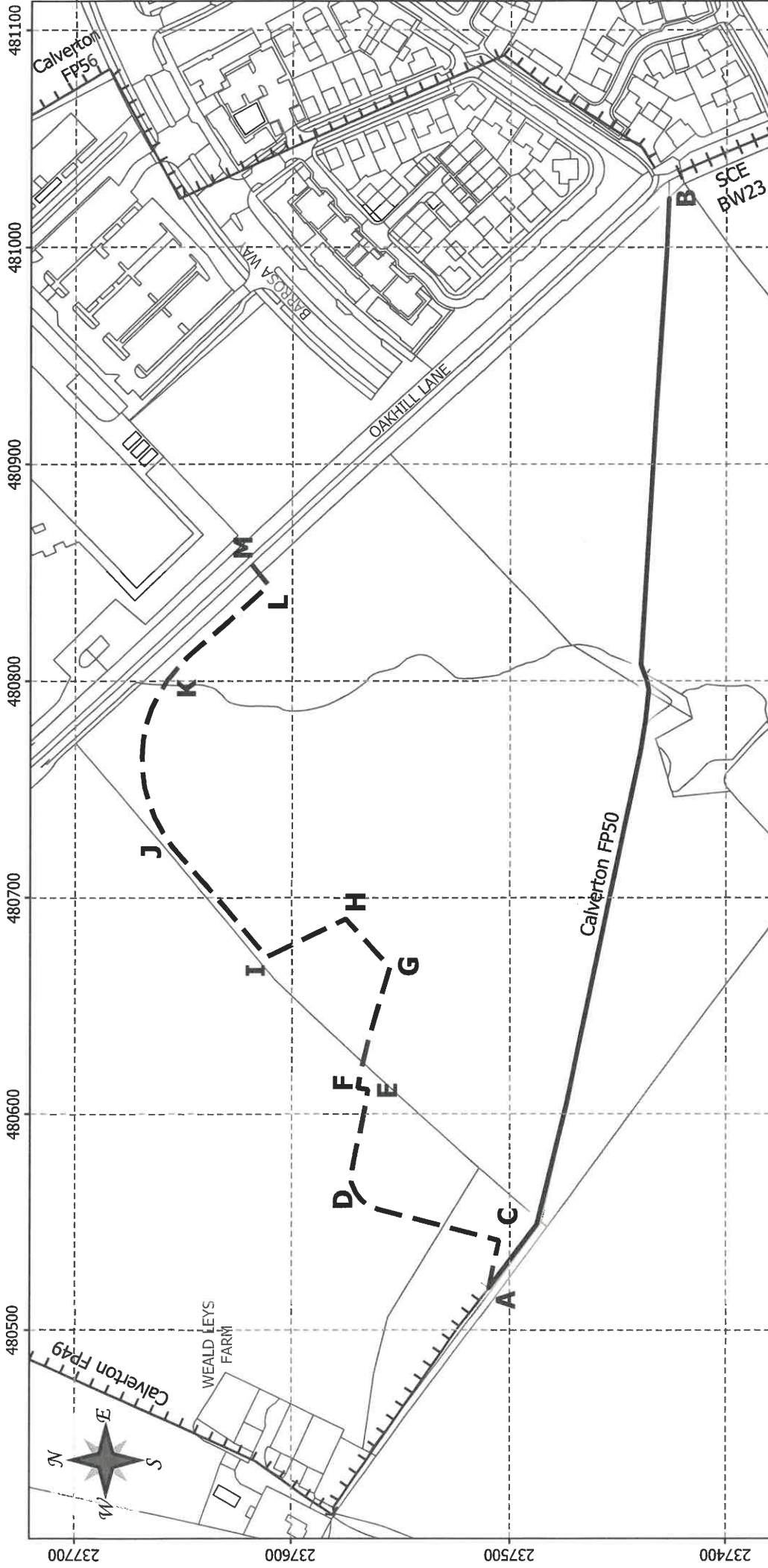
PART 2

Description of site of alternative highway

(1) Alternative Calverton Footpath 50

From point A (OS Grid Reference SP80519 37510) in a generally east south easterly direction for approximately 23 metres to point C (OS Grid Reference SP80541 37505), then in a generally north north easterly direction for 69 metres to point D (OS Grid Reference 80560 37567), then in a generally east south easterly direction for 49 metres to point E (OS Grid Reference SP80611 37564), then in a generally northerly direction for 5 metres to point F (OS Grid Reference SP80612 37568), then in a generally east south easterly direction for 58 metres to point G (OS Grid Reference SP80667 37555), then in a generally north easterly direction for 30 metres to point H (OS Grid Reference SP80690 37575), then in a generally north north westerly direction for 40 metres to point I (OS Grid Reference SP80673 37611), then in a generally north easterly direction for 75 metres to point J (OS Grid Reference SP80729 37660), then in a generally easterly direction for 89 metres to point K (OS Grid Reference SP80811 37648), then in a generally south easterly direction for 50 metres to point L (OS Grid Reference SP80843 37609), then in a generally north easterly direction for 12 metres to terminate at point M (OS Grid Reference SP80853 37618).

The alternative way will travel upon a compacted stone surface and have a length of approximately 500 metres and a width of 2 metres throughout as indicated by the points stated above on the Order map by bold black dashed lines.
