## THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (FOREST ROAD, HANSLOPE) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 84(1), (2) and (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the above proposed Order will be to extend the existing 30mph speed limit restriction and introduce a 40mph speed limit restriction along the following lengths of Forest Road in Hanslope:

### **30mph Speed Limit Restriction**

From its junction with Hartwell Road, for a distance of 249 metres in a north-easterly direction

### **40mph Speed Limit Restriction**

From a point 249 metres north-east of its junction with Hartwell Road, for a distance of 483 metres in a north-easterly direction

The proposed alterations to the speed limits on Forest Road come as a result of the agreed section 278 works for the new Hanslope housing development by Davidson Developments.

As the Highway Authority for Forest Road in Hanslope, Milton Keynes Council is satisfied that the alterations to the speed limit restrictions will encourage the convenient and safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

Milton Keynes Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the above proposal.
