The Regulations state that Supplementary Statements can provide updates to the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment only in relation to changes in the availability of pharmaceutical services. Supplementary Statements cannot provide updates on pharmaceutical need. This can only be achieved through a review of the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment. The following pharmaceutical services currently contained within the Pharmaceutical Needs Assessment have been identified as needing updating. This updated information supersedes some of the original information within the PNA and should be read in conjunction with that document.

Removal from pharmaceutical list:

The following pharmacies have been removed from the pharmaceutical list for Milton Keynes Health and Care Partnership area:

- Boots UK Ltd, T/A Boots (FAM80), at Unit 2A, Beacon Retail Park, Bletchley Way, Milton Keynes MK1 1BN.
This pharmacy has closed with effect from 9 April 2022 and NHSE have removed them from the pharmaceutical list.
- Boots UK Ltd, T/A Boots (FM359), at 1 The Concourse Brunel Centre, Bletchley, Milton Keynes MK2 2ES.
This pharmacy has closed with effect from 16 April 2022 and NHSE have removed them from the pharmaceutical list.

Change of opening hours:

The following pharmacies in Milton Keynes Health and Care Partnership area have changed their opening hours:

- Lloyds Pharmacy (FGP72), at 2 Kingfisher Centre, Elthorne Way, Newport Pagnell MK16 0JR.

New opening hours (effective from 9 June 2022):

- Monday to Friday: 09:00-13:00, 13:00-17:30
- Saturday and Sunday: Closed

All other details remain the same.

- PCT Healthcare, T/A Peak Pharmacy (FCV71), at 239 Queensway, Bletchey, Milton Keynes MK2 2EH.

New opening hours (effective from 19 September 2022):

- Monday to Friday: 09:00-13:00, 14:00-18:00
- Saturday and Sunday: Closed

All other details remain the same.

MK HCP concludes that the closures and changes stated above do not constitute a gap in service provision that could be met by a routine application (a) to meet a current need or future need for pharmaceutical services, or (b) to secure improvements, or better access to, pharmaceutical services.
