

Hoarding on the Highways

Terms and conditions

The licensee is responsible for the suspension of any parking bays and for providing all banks men, signage, barriers, ramps etc. as agreed in the traffic management plan. These items shall be checked and secured in the correct position each morning prior to commencing work.

Permission for hoarding does not extend to the parking of vehicles or loading or unloading of materials.

The licensee shall ensure all parking, loading and waiting restrictions are adhered to.

Boards, drills or associated fittings are not to be stored on the highway during erecting and dismantling the hoarding.

The hoarding company name and contact details shall be clearly displayed on the structure point.

Where Planning Permission, Building Control approval or any other consent is required for the proposed works, the relevant authorisation shall be in place prior to requesting a permit and placing a hoarding and conveyor on site.

The hoarding permit does not include welfare units, site huts or temporary toilets. These items require separate permit approvals.

The hoarding will not obstruct access to any inspection covers in the public footway.

Important notice

A site meeting prior to the application must be held with a site report completed and appropriate photographs.
