Answers: 5 things that can't be recycled in the clear sack

- **1. The disposable nappy**. Black bin bag please. Unfortunately, we receive over 300 nappies ever day in clear sacks disposable nappies cannot be recycled!
- 2. Old clothes. Please take to the charity shop. Poor quality clothing into the black bin bag.
- **3. Carrier bags.** These get tangled in the Recycling Facility machinery. Please recycle at the supermarket soft plastic recycling drop off points.
- **4. Crisp packets.** Please recycle at the supermarket soft plastic recycling drop off points, as well as biscuit wrappers, sweet wrappers and pet food pouches.
- **5. Food.** All food waste must go in the green wheeled bin so it can be turned into compost. This also stops rats and foxes ripping open bin bags.

4 things people think can't be recycled but can be...

- 1. Lids. Metal and plastic lids can be placed in the recycling sack, preferably on the bottle.
- 2. Aerosols, e.g. deodorant, hair spray, squirty cream cans, etc. if spray can is empty it can go in the recycling sack.
- **3. Windowed envelopes**. No need to cut out the window any longer. Manufacturers now make the envelope windows recyclable.
- **4. Plastic tubs**, e.g. yoghurt pots, fruit punnets. These can be recycled in the clear recycling sack.
