Robin tree decoration

Cut out robin shape from old cardboard cereal box. Add red plastic lid, googly eye and a small piece of ribbon.

Home made gift tags

Use up old Christmas cards but cutting down, hole punch the corner and add a colourful ribbon to create a gift tag.





Snowflakes

Take a square piece of paper or wrapping paper, fold in half to make a triangle. Fold again to make a smaller triangle. Use scissors to cut out shapes from the sides of the triangle. Unfold to reveal your beautiful snowflake.

Using all of the ideas from above now turn these into lovely home made Christmas cards for your friends and family.

An old favourite, but still looks amazing! Cut scraps of colourful paper or leftover wrapping paper into thin strips, glue into a circle and then thread through the next strip & glue again. Hang from the ceiling or noticeboard.
