### **Statutory Consultation – Proposed double yellow line restrictions in Neath Hill**

Milton Keynes City Council is consulting on a parking scheme in Neath Hill and your property has been identified as potentially being affected by the proposals.

The scheme will introduce 'no waiting at any time restriction' (double yellow lines) along parts of Glazier Drive, Currier Drive, Armourer Drive, Serjeants Green, Tower Drive and Tower Crescent in Neath Hill (as illustrated on the enclosed drawing).

The above proposed restrictions come as a result of safety concerns raised over inconsiderate and obstructive parking at junctions, crossings and accesses.

As the Highway Authority for the above lengths of road, Milton Keynes City Council is satisfied that the introduction of the above proposed restrictions will help to alleviate obstruction and encourage a safer environment for pedestrians and cyclists.
